The project aims to:

- reduce early school dropout through speed up the learning process
- overcome shortage of specialists at schools (psychologist, pedagogues)
- improve engagement of parents in learning processes of their children and development of their cognitive abilities
- offer free-of-charge and barrier-free tools (including the ICT- based ones), for diagnosis of cognitive processes and the preferred learning style of children aged 6-14 years old
- offer free-of-charge training programmes and educational-oriented materials for parents, educators to support pupils in the development of effective learning skills





The four main intellectual outputs are:

- Output 1 Electronic tool for diagnosis of cognitive processes and learning styles of younger children (6-10 years old)
- Output 2 Electronic tool for diagnosis of cognitive processes and learning styles for older children (11-14 years old)
- Output 3 Training toolkit for teachers and educators
- Output 4 Educational toolkit for students













Third project meeting



Join the International Pilot Testing

The Electronic Tool for the diagnosis of cognitive processes of children between 6-10 years old is ready for pilot testing!

The tool investigates children's cognitive processes and learning styles.



The piloting is conducted in the period January-June 2021 in Poland, Greece, Cyprus, Italy and Romania.

Due to the young age of pupils (recipients of the electronic diagnostic tool) and their cognitive abilities to take part in the diagnosis (self-assessment) of their own cognitive function, the test should be completed by parents or teachers based on observation and good knowledge of a child. It should involve 100 teachers and 100 parents/caregivers per country.

We invite schools, parents and teachers across the countries to join the project and piloting! We will reward you with the certificate of participation and firsthand access to the developed project products!
